We'd like to see your child at school

The Coronavirus affects the whole of society and everyday life may look very different to many people. We would therefore like to draw your attention to the fact that the schools are still open in the same way as before. We are providing pupils with as normal an education as possible during the Coronavirus pandemic. Teaching continues according to the primary and secondary school curriculum. Assessments are carried out regularly and grades will be issued at the end of term as usual.

We need your help

School is compulsory and all children have a right to education. That means that a pupil who is healthy must be at school.

This is where we need your help. As a guardian, you have the ultimate responsibility for ensuring that your child is at school and has access to education. The school follows the recommendations of the Public Health Agency of Sweden, which means that, at present, the schools are open and providing education.

At school, we repeat the information about the importance of washing your hands, social distancing and staying at home if you are experiencing any cold-like symptoms. When the pupil or member of staff is free from symptoms, they must stay at home for another two days.

We have also introduced new procedures for excursions as well as clear restrictions on visitors to the school.

The staff at the school will help your child to return to education.
